This month in American history:

Every month we like to share the anniversaries of our military, here are just a few...



December 3, 1775:

1st official US flag raising (aboard naval vessel Alfred)
Alfred became the first vessel to fly the Grand Union Flag (the precursor to the Stars and Stripes); the flag was hoisted on the Delaware River by John Paul Jones. This event was documented in letters to Congress.



December 7, 1941:

Japanese attack Pearl Harbor (a date that will live in infamy) surprise aerial attack on the U.S. naval base at Pearl Harbor on Oahu Island, Hawaii, by the Japanese that precipitated the entry of the United States into World War II. The strike climaxed a decade of worsening relations between the United States and Japan.



December 14 1944:

Congress establishes rank of General of Army (5-star General)

The title is temporary and only used during wartime. A General of the Army is appointed when the commanding officer must be of higher rank than armies of other nations.



December 20, 1957:

Elvis Presley given draft notice to join US Army for National Service. Having been deferred twice since 1953, by March 24, Elvis was just another private in the Army.
